“ One spring day in Spartanburg, South Carolina, I observed an elderly couple gently walking hand in hand into Ollie's, as I was coming out of the store. I'd already left my husband at least six feet behind, but I was compelled by the Holy Spirit, to walk over to this couple (whom I didn't know) to compliment them. I said to them, "How beautiful you look! I'm going to start holding hands with my husband as we walk!" They smiled and we started talking. Our time conversing with each other gave my husband time to catch up with me and he joined in the conversation.

Though we were strangers at the time, we were comfortable talking to each. Some months later, this couple visited New Pilgrim Baptist Church. I was so glad to see them again; so, immediately after worship service, I went over to ask if they'd remembered meeting us in the parking lot at Ollie's! Of course, they'd remembered and our friendship flourished from that point! "Sister Sylvia" and I remain (though she has transitioned) sisters in Christ. She was such a soft spoken, genuinely loving child of the King.

From the time of meeting "Sister Sylvia" she battled some health challenges. However, anytime I'd ask her, "How are you Sister Sylvia", consistently she would say, "Fair." Sometimes, after saying "Fair", she would say "I'm a little shaky today." I never ever heard her espouse anxiety, express concerns about pain, nor otherwise complain. She was deeply grounded in her faith in God and she would often ask for prayer; therefore, we prayed together often.

More often than not, she would end our telephone conversations with these words, "I love you Sister Lillie." My response to her, "I love you too Sister Sylvia."

I thank God for having known Sister Sylvia. She is a wonderful child of the God the Father! Given that her spirit is absent from her body, I know that she is present with the Lord as we (His children) will all be present with Him someday.

I pray God's continued favor on son her Sean, niece Ashley, her sister Francis, niece Natasha, he brother Robert (Carolyn), the entire family and ALL who were so fortunate to have know Sister Sylvia.
