Tameka LaNelle Stokes was born on November 5, 1980 at Hutzel Hospital in Detroit, MI to Morris James Reynolds and Melba Louise Stokes.

She graduated from Cass Technical High School in 1998 before going on to study Theater Arts at Dillard University in New Orleans, LA. Wanting to be closer to family, Tameka moved back home to Detroit where she completed her studies at Specs Howard School of Media Arts.

She loved being active and as a child and teenager enjoyed the violin, trumpet, guitar, basketball, playing tennis with her dad and skiing in Denver. She even learned to shoot and handle firearms.

Tameka had her first bout with cancer in 2000 where she fought lymphoma into remission.

During her career, Tameka was always quickly promoted into leadership positions. While working for Best Buy, she was asked to join their Projects Team where she traveled the US assisting with the opening and remodeling of new stores. While working at TGI Friday's, her outstanding service was noticed and she was eventually recruited to work at Como's Restaurant. In

2012, Tameka moved from Detroit to Chicago where she would work for Devon's Seafood Grill. She was promoted up the ranks from server, to trainer and hospitality supervisor.

Tameka had so many friends and has touched so many lives. She was dedicated, hardworking, and fiercely loyal as a daughter, sister, aunt, niece, cousin and friend.

Tameka transitioned from this life just a few days after her 37th birthday, on November 10, 2017 after a battle with breast cancer. She accepted Christ during her last days.

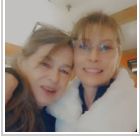
