Terry Dumas, Jr. was born on August 30, 1936, in Detroit, Michigan, to Terry Dumas and Susie Mae Dumas. After high school, Terry joined the United States Air Force, serving from 1954 to 1958 at Elgin Air Force Base and the 3201st USAF Hospital. He continued to serve in the Air Force reserves for an additional 4 years before being honorably discharged.

Terry had a successful 20-year career with the State of Michigan in the Information Technology department, ultimately becoming an IT Supervisor before retiring in June 1997.

Terry was married to Gloria for 47 years and took great pride in raising her amazing, outstanding, handsome, and accomplished son LaFell.

Terry was talented and successful in many endeavors. He spent years playing semi-pro softball, traveling across the Midwest for tournaments. He was also an accomplished bowler, earning numerous accolades and trophies. However, his true passion was golf, and he spent decades chasing birdies (and sometimes bogeys) with his friends on golf courses across the Midwest and beyond.
