The Journey Of Thelma Christian-Taylor

On May 8, 1951, God released one of His Angels-Thelma Christian-into the loving union of the late Samuel Lee Christian and Rosie L. Warren-Christian in Uniontown, Alabama. To this union nine children were born, one of whom preceded her in death (James Edward Christian).

She confessed Christ at an early age and became a member of New Mount Olive Missionary Baptist Church in Uniontown, Alabama.

In 1969 she graduated from MCTS/ Amelia Love Johnson High. She later moved to Fort Wayne, Indiana where she was employed with General Electric for approximately six months. After being laid off from General Electric she moved to Detroit, Michigan. In 1971 she was employed with Grand Trunk Railroad as a switchboard operator where she dedicated her service for over 9 years. Finally, in 2003 she began working for the Public School System in the transportation department as a bus driver until she retired in 2013 after 10 years of service.

On December 11, 1970, Thelma united in holy matrimony to Richard Taylor and to this union two children were born.

Thelma joined New Birth Missionary Baptist Church in 1979 where she served as a faithful member. In 1995, she joined Pleasant Hill Missionary Baptist under the leadership of Rev. Dr. Terry White Sr. She was also a member of the choir and served as Assistant Superintendent of Sunday School until her health failed.

On Sunday, March 30, 2014 God saw that His angel was getting tired so he called Thelma home to rest.
