Theodore Robert Griffin, Jr., was born March 20, 1936 in Detroit, Michigan to Theodore Griffin, Sr. and Lillie Louise Duncan who both preceded him in death. He was the oldest of four siblings: Rosalind (who preceded him in death), Kittrell and Cassandra.

At a young age, it was obvious that he was a very precocious child and also athletic. In high school, at Southeastern, he played baseball and ran track. He was all-city and state in track and field. He graduated in 1954 and soon thereafter he joined the U.S. Army. After serving his country, Theodore was discharged with a medical disability.

In 1964, Theodore began working for Chrysler Dodge Main Plant where he spent 10 years. He then retired due to his military disability.

Theodore loved life and lived it to the limits. Before his illness, he enjoyed his motorcycle and his fast cars. Affectionately known as "Ever Ready Teddy" he was always on the move.

In his later years, he was a resident of the VA Medical Center in the nursing center area where he had many friends and was well cared for.
