His Journey:

Trent Duerson was born in Detroit, Michigan on June 10, 1958 to the late John Irvine Duerson and Dorothy Duerson. He was the eldest of two children. He was baptized at an early age by the late Reverend Stephen Campbell at Russell Street Missionary Baptist Church in Detroit, Michigan. After a brief illness, Trent departed this life on Sunday, December 7, 2014 at 4:16 p.m. as his beloved Lions sent him on to Glory with a victory; he listened to the game until the final tick of the clock.

Affectionately known as “Greek” to his boys at Central High School in Detroit, Michigan, Trent became a sports enthusiast and was a true “Detroit Fan”; cheering on the Lions, Pistons and Tigers. In addition to playing high school football, he also enjoyed bowling. Trent graduated from Central in June 1976 and attended college in San Bernardino, California for a short period of time. He returned to Detroit and became employed at the Chrysler Corporation in Sterling Heights, Michigan at the age of 19 and remained there until his retirement in 2007. At Chrysler, Trent received numerous service awards and made many friends and often served as a mentor to several junior employees. He rarely missed a day of work and his week often exceeded 40 hours; he was a loyal employee until he punched the time clock for the last time.

Trent enjoyed the finer things in life and was considered a “dapper dresser”

who loved his hats and gators. In addition to his love for sports and dancing, Trent had a penchant for music, particularly jazz, and had an extensive CD collection that could rival anyone's. In his own mind, he was a master at playing dominoes and bid whist. If you ever played whist with him you wanted to make sure you were his partner so as to not endure his "trash talking" when he made a bid or especially if he "ran a Boston." He enjoyed life to the fullest and an ordinary gathering only became a party after Trent arrived and he could usually be heard before he was seen.
