



## Baby Tristan Alexander Clark

March 7, 2013 - June 11, 2013

Tristan Alexander Clark was born on Thursday, March 7, 2013 at 10:08 P.M. at William Beaumont Hospital in Royal Oak, MI. He weighed in at 7 lb. 8 oz. and measured at 20 in. Tristan was born bluish in color due to his congenital conditions Heterotaxy Syndrome and Situs Inversus Abdominalis (stomach and liver switched). At the time of his birth the four chambers of his heart were completely open, and he had a narrow aortic artery. Despite all of his conditions Tristan was a brave and strong fighter. It was the 13th of March when Tristan had his first heart surgery. In the short days after his surgery Tristan had an astonishing recovery rate, earning him the nickname Wolverine. Tristan was cared for by many nurses, and flirted with them all with big smiles and baby talk.

At home he would very often fight with his older sister Samiah over the rights of who would be the baby. With his oldest sister Arian, he was always under her loving watchful eye. He spent the majority of his days competing with his dad over mommy's attention (he won every time). On an average day Tristan would usually play with his favorite toy, activity play mat with the piano foot piece, that he constantly kicked with his left foot and occasionally his right foot. After a long and eventful day Tristan would usually stay up late with his dad, spending quality time watching movies, fussing over late night feedings and fighting to stay awake.

During Tristan's second month of life he experienced his second surgery due to his bottom chambers in his heart healing. It wasn't until after the third surgery when Tristan began to experience complications. On June 11, 2013 at 5:15 P.M., the Lord called him home to be with his grandmother Marlene and great-grandmother Hiawatha.
