Vearlina's story:

Vearlina Patton was born December 6, 1951 in Moundville, Alabama to Ruth Lee Patton. Two years after Vearlina's birth, her mother married Charlie H. Eubanks and she was legally adopted. Vearlina was taken to church every Sunday and learned of the almighty and his son Jesus of Nazareth. At a responsible age Vearlina gave her life over to the Lord and never looked back. In Alabama, Vearlina attended 20th Street Elementary, Central Jr. and Druid High School. Vearlina's parents and siblings resided in Tuscaloosa, Alabama until the age of 16 when mother and then stepfather Joe R. Brown moved to Detroit, Michigan in 1968.

In Detroit, Vearlina attended Northwestern High School, graduating in 1970. She attended Eastern Michigan University, Marygrove College and WC3. Vearlina obtained two degrees.

Vearlina was married to her dear husband Frank Clemons for 43 years, and out of their union, there were two children and a total blending of nine children from her spouse's previous marriage.

Vearlina was employed at Detroit Steel Strip Division and 24 years at First Federal Savings & Loan, as office clerical, supervisor and then a department officer. Vearlina was later employed at the Michigan Women's Foundation in

administration (office manager) for ten years. Vearlina retired from outside work to become a caregiver to her loving mother for the next ten years.

Vearlina and Frank attended Living Word Ministries for over 30 years under the leadership of Pastor Robert E. Simmons. Vearlina was and is loved by all due to her humble spirit, loving advice and acceptance of everyone. Vearlina was often called a bookworm because she was forever reading and studying from childhood to her departure. She loved watching television in her spare time, visiting friends and family and dining out.

Vearlina is preceded in death by her mother, father (adopted) and stepfather; three siblings, Josephine Eaddy, Norzella Stone and Yolanda Brown.

Vearlina departed from this life on Sunday, April 1, 2018.
