Vernon was born on October 14, 1938 in Winston-Salem, North Carolina to Lillie Wade Hall and Will Hall. He spent his formative years in his hometown, where he attended 14th Elementary School and graduated from Atkins High School. He joined the Navy after graduating and honorably served from 1956-1959. He then attended Winston-Salem Teachers College. While matriculating at Winston-Salem Teachers and he was initiated into Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity. He also met and later married Shirley Counts at Winston-Salem Teachers College. From this union two children were born.

After graduating from Winston-Salem Teachers College with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Elementary Education, he accepted a teaching position in Lynchburg, Virginia and then in Detroit, Michigan. He worked in the Detroit Public Schools from 1964-1997; first as a teacher of mathematics and then promoted by the Detroit Public Schools to a Regional Consultant Instructional Specialist in Mathematics.

Fueled by his love for knowledge, Vernon, at an early stage in his career, continued his education at the University of Detroit, earning a Master of Science Degree in Education in 1973.

Vernon had a spirit of humility and much kindness. He enjoyed being an

educator.

When it came to his family, Vernon's love and compassion overflowed. He simply adored his family. He was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, loving brother and uncle.

On Friday, December 2, 2016 the Lord ordered the final steps of Vernon Francis Hall Sr. while at home. Vernon took God's hand and quietly and peacefully entered into eternal rest.
