Veta Harvin, best known as Honey, was born on September 11, 1922 to Richard and Essie Harvin in Sumter, South Carolina.

She was the fifth of 8 children (7 who preceded her in death). She departed this life at 95 years on February 22, 2018.

Upon coming to Detroit, she confessed Christ at an early age and joined St. John's Presbyterian Church where she served as elder, deacon, sang with the Chancel Choir and was a faithful member for many years serving her community and family.

She met and married the late Phineas Miller. To this union the following siblings were united Margaret, Aubrey and Leroy, Phineas Jerome (preceded her in death).

Veta continued her education and received her Bachelor's degree in Education from the University of Detroit and taught in the Detroit Public Schools system for many years until her retirement.

Veta enjoyed singing, traveling, reciting poetry, being with family and friends and encouraging young people to pursue their goals. She joined the Eastern

Star in 1954 and was awarded Worthy Matron in 1974.
