The Life Story Of Walter Lacy:

Walter Lacy was the only child born to the late James and Viola Lacy on April 4, 1924 in Robertsville, Mississippi.

After being educated in the Robertsville school system, Walter relocated to Detroit, Michigan.

Walter served in World War II as a Winch Operator, and was honorably discharged from the U.S. Army in 1946. Walter was responsible for the supervision of five enlisted military personnel and was the recipient of several honors and medals, which include the World War II Victory Ribbon, two Bronze Service Stars, Good Conduct Medal and an acknowledgement of service from President Harry Truman.

Walter married the former Helen Webb on February 24, 1949. To this union, five children were born; daughter, Patricia Elaine, and sons; Michael, Martin, Walter and David.

Walter worked for the Chrysler Corporation and became a skilled automotive spray painter until his retirement in 1989 after 30 years of dedicated service.

side by side until his health declined.
