Mr. Walter Van Wagner, the loving Patriarch of the Wagner family passed away Wednesday October 28, 2015 at Seasons Hospice in Detroit, Michigan.

If you knew Walter, two things were apparent, he loved to dress and he loved to eat, which was amazing in that he would not gain weight and always looked dapper in his clothing.
