Wilbur H. S. Carr, Sr. was born to Thomas and Hazel Elizabeth Sampson Carr on June 19, 1942 of this union. His two older brothers Bobby and Benny, both preceded him in death along with his parents. Wilbur aka "Willie" aka "Rebel" was the third child. He was reared in the fear of God.

Wilbur was educated in the Virginia Public Schools in Rockingham County where he graduated from high school and enlisted in the United States Army where he received a purple heart. He was honorably discharged due to wounds received as a result of action with enemy forces in the Vietnam War where he served three faithful years for his country in 1965.

Upon his discharge, Wilbur married his sweetheart Elinda Bessard Carr, parents to Wilbur K. Carr Jr., Stephen Warren, Nathan Warren, Veronica Roy (along with Robert Hunt, Leroy Hunt, and Joseph Warren who preceded Wilbur in his death).

Wilbur was a full-time bodyguard for the late great Prophetess Leslie R. Brown, a master mechanic by trade and a welder. He had a passion for photography and enjoyed fishing, hunting and anything to do with the open outdoors.
