On March 3, 1958, Liza gave birth to her first baby girl, Sharon Denice. Liza worked hard to provide her daughters every want and need.

After the death of both her parents, Liza moved with her daughter to Highland Park, Michigan for a better life.

On October 17, 1966, Liza was united in holy matrimony to Henry C. Sneed. To this union her baby daughter, Cassandra Renee was born.
